HOW TO ENTER

1. To fill out the form to register your entry
2. To pay the £10 entry fee separately – [CLICK HERE](#)
3. Read the Rules for Entry
4. Get to work and create a beautiful A3-sized quilted piece inspired by your memories
5. Once your piece is stitched (or you have a sketch of your proposed design) email one high-resolution image to: **competitions@ichf.co.uk** (j.peg files are preferable) **by 3rd September 2021**. Please label the image file with your name and category.
7. All completed entries must be posted to Margo Hunter between **4th-8th October 2021** (see Rules of Entry for details).

All competitors will receive an entry acknowledgement, which includes a '2 for 1' discount code to share with family and friends.

HOW THE COMPETITION WILL WORK

- An exhibition of all entries will be displayed for visitors to admire at **Glasgow SEC Creative Craft Show**, between **14th-17th October 2021**.
- The competition will be judged on the first day of the show on **Thursday 14th October 2021**. Awards will be given for 1st, 2nd and 3rd winners.
- The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into. There are no cash alternatives to the prizes on offer.
- Winners will be notified by telephone on **Thursday 14th October 2021** and announced on Social Media after the judging has taken place.
 - The award for the **Visitors choice** will be announced after The Creative Craft show has finished, during the week commencing **18th October 2021**.
- **Prizes** for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd winners will be awarded at The Creative Craft Show on **Sunday 17th October 2021** at 3pm. The Visitors choice prize will be arranged after the show.

A3 MEMORY QUILT COMPETITION 2021

RULES OF ENTRY

ENTRIES

1. This competition is open to all quilters' in the British Isles. Quilts entered into this competition should be single-sided and not previously entered into any other competition.
2. Only one piece maybe entered and competitors must complete an entry form by the closing date. All entries must be the bonafide work of the individual who has entered.
3. A hanging sleeve of 1 ¼ inches (3cm) must be attached to the back of the quilt. Failure to provide this will mean that the piece cannot be displayed.
4. All entries must measure A3: 11 ¾ x 16 ½ inches (29.5cm x 42cm)
5. We reserve the right to NOT hang work that contains any sharp or dangerous materials, or which, the Organisers' feel is unsuitable in anyway for display.
6. Your name, address and phone number must be clearly and securely attached to the back of your work to enable us to identify your piece. **Please do not label the front** – to ensure anonymity during the judging process.
7. We endeavour to hang all pieces, which comply with the Rules of Entry, where we receive an entry form by the due date, but this cannot be guaranteed and the Organisers reserve the right not to display any piece for whatever reason.

PACKAGING AND POSTING YOUR EMBROIDERY

1. Packaging the quilt is the maker's responsibility, but we advise rolling it around a small tube, or if sending flat, add a strong piece of card and then wrap it with a piece of bubble wrap for protection.
2. Attach a 'From' label to your parcel, to enable us to identify your entry. Make sure your labels are clear as to whom the parcel is 'To' and 'From'. Please use **BLOCK CAPITALS**. Please also enclose a **SELF-ADDRESSED RETURN LABEL** for your package.

REMOVAL OF EXHIBITS FROM THE SHOW

All entries must be removed at the stated time and not before. Collection can commence from 4.30pm to 5.30pm on Sunday. Please be aware of this rule when arranging your travel plans. **Proof of ID must be shown** to enable you to collect your quilt from the show. The Organisers' reserve the right to remove any quilt not taken by 7pm on Sunday 17th October 2021. Any remaining quilts will be sent back within one calendar month.
